Course: Initial Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Course

This is an Accredited EPA Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program Course (Required to fulfill EPA 40 CFR Part 745 effective April 22, 2010)

Who should take this class?

The rule will affect paid renovators who work in pre-1978 housing and child-occupied facilities, including:

- Renovation contractor
- Maintenance workers in multi-family housing
- Painters, Window Installers and other specialty trades.

Under the rule, child-occupied facilities are defined as residential, public or commercial buildings where children under age six are present on a regular basis. The requirements apply to renovation, repair or painting activities. The rule does not apply to minor maintenance or repair activities where less than 6 square feet of lead-based paint is disturbed in a room or where less than 20 square feet of lead-based paint is disturbed on the exterior. *Window replacement is not minor maintenance or repair.*
